## Home News

Last month we enjoyed 2 mini bus trips out, a BBQ and an apetito tasting afternoon. We will be reviewing the menu at our next residents meeting and looking at outing some new options on the autumn/winter menu.

The garden visits continue with 1 designated family member/visitor however the summer cabin is being delivered next week and the work with start building it the week commencing  $14^{th}$  September. Visits will then be facilitated in there.

It has been very hot and we have been ordering in ice creams and ice lollies! This has gone down a treat and therefore will continue for different options at meal times and on the 3pm tea trolley.

The District Nurses have started coming back into the home for basic interventions such as bloods and dressings.

Staff have continued to be tested weekly. We are currently awaiting a new batch of tests to arrive so we can commence resident testing again.

Flu jabs will be available again this year and the Practice Nurse will be coming into the home to do these around October time.

We are open to admissions and are producing a video of the home for the website as new admissions are unable to physical look round the home. If you would like to be involved in this or give a testimonial to the home, then please make Sarah aware.

Tamla will be away from Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September to Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> September and has made up some activity packs for that period.

Sarah continues to print off the Sunday Church sermon for residents and this is placed on the side board in the dining room.
